Dear Groundskeeper/Ranger Applicant,

We strive to keep Camp Michael a wonderful place for the youth and adults of Crawford and surrounding counties to visit and learn about nature. We carry out this mission with a welcoming demeanor and a keen interest in the safety of our guests.

This position has its positives, and its negatives just like all positions do. At times, the Ranger position can be demanding. Therefore, before filling out an application, please take a few moments and look over the job description document. Here are several key factors you might want to consider up front

- Weekends are our busiest times. Therefore, the Ranger will need to be available during most weekends throughout the year to attend to the needs of our guests.
- The Ranger will need to be available during reasonable times to attend to the needs of our potential guests and their requests.
- Camp Michael is not affiliated with Scouting America; however, we support them, and their members are frequently at the Camp. As a result, no tobacco use is a strongly preferred characteristic of our Ranger.
- Some of the work around the Camp –such as stocking firewood at the campsites can require considerable physical effort. The Camp Ranger must be physically able to perform the necessary tasks.
- The Ranger is not technically an employee of Camp Michael, therefore, while there is no pay or benefits, you would in effect be exchanging your work at the Camp for rent of the Ranger's residence and garage. Of course, use of the facilities—camping, archery, buildings, and firearms range (within reason as determined by the Board of Directors)- is free of charge during a Ranger's tenure.
